His Helping Hands includes all of the organizers, volunteers, and supporters of the stated effort to help those in need.

His Helping Hands is operated by a Board of Directors made up of local business men and women, construction professionals, ministers, and lay leaders. It is a non-profit, tax exempt organization.

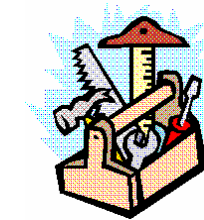
His Helping Hands work is carried out by volunteer teams led by experienced team leaders. A volunteer can be anyone with a desire and willingness to help. Experience is not necessary. Volunteers may work on as many or as few projects as they desire.

WHAT IS *HIS HELPING HANDS* DOING?

REQUESTS for needed work can be made by mailing a letter to *His Helping Hands*, 2527 W Rohmann Ave., Peoria, IL 61604. Emergency re-



quests are forwarded to *His Helping Hands* by local churches and service agencies including Habitat for Humanity, United Way and Central Illinois Agency on Aging.

PRIORITY is given to elderly or disabled people who meet income guidelines and who cannot do the repairs themselves and have no able-bodied family members who could do the work.

SELECTION of projects is made by the Board of Directors in order of greatest need.
